This year's honorees included Dennis McCarthy, Journalist, receiving the Jackie Lacey "Voice of the Community " Award; Mechanix Wear receiving the Chuck Street "Sky's the Limit" Award; and Edward Lowder, MD (C·A·T·S founder) receiving the Rafer Johnson "Medal of Justice" Award. Councilwoman Nury Martinez office presented (C·A·T·S) with a certificate for all its dedicated work within the community and Congressman Brad Sherman's office presented (C·A·T·S) with a flag that flew over the White House.

Then, 1,348 runners were off to the races, many of them as members of the 58 registered teams.

Upon crossing the finish line, all enjoyed the 45 booths in our Expo. All participants received finisher medals and t-shirts!
