NHMC Awards \$187,314 in Community Grants

Each year, Northridge Hospital participates in the Dignity Health Community Grant Program, which focuses on supporting nonprofit community organizations whose mission is to provide access to healthcare services for underserved populations.

This year we were proud to award seven grants - totaling **\$187,314**. Including our recipients this year, Northridge Hospital is proud to say that over the last 16 years we have awarded 102 grants totaling more than \$2.16 Million dollars.

Congratulations to the 2016 - 2017 grant recipients who received their grants and were recognized at the Community Board of Directors meeting on February 15.

- **Triumph Foundation \$15,000** This grant will provide for a range of services to the newly paralyzed and others living with disabilities.
- **Center for Living and Learning \$20,000** Funds from this grant will expand outreach, education and case management for those transitioning from drug treatment, incarceration, welfare and homelessness through health care access, job placement and more.
- **MEND Meet Each Need with Dignity Health \$26,000** This grant funds the purchase and installation of new computers by each dental chair to implement EHR and support additional 8-hour Saturday dental clinic days.
- Valley Care Community Consortium (VCCC) \$29,000 This grant will continue the work begun by NHMC's Center for Healthier Communities to reduce childhood obesity through community education.
- **Coalition to Abolish Slavery and Trafficking (CAST) \$30,000** This grant will improve the San Fernando Valley capacity for identification of victims and survivors of labor and sex trafficking and increased provider training.
- Mid-Valley Family YMCA \$30,000 Diabetes Wellness Rx will provide the Type 2 Diabetes community with education and resources to help them to better self-manage their diabetes.
- **Tarzana Treatment Centers \$37,314** To reduce ED use for primary care, this grant will coordinate patient care through a Behavioral Health Navigator as well as provide referred patients with access to primary, preventative care and substance abuse treatment.
