Northridge Hospital Foundation has received a \$100,000 grant from the Avon Foundation for Women for the Leavey Cancer Center's Patient Navigator Program. The grant was presented to **Jill Dickson**, Director of Cancer Services, and **Lori Kent**, Manager of Grants, during the final ceremonies for the Avon Walk in Santa Barbara. Our Navigator Program has been instrumental in providing thousands of low-income women with greater awareness about breast health through educational presentations, free mammograms, diagnostic services, and reduced lost-to-follow-up rates. Women who are diagnosed with breast cancer work closely with our Certified Clinical Navigator and a multidisciplinary team to meet their unique needs from diagnosis to post-treatment.
