Avon Foundation for Women Awards \$100,000 Grant for Our Navigator Program

pleased to announce that Avon Foundation for Women has awarded a \$100,000 grant for the Leavey Cancer Center's Patient Navigator Program. Kevin Honeycutt, Executive Director of the Avon Foundation for Women presented a check to Jill Dickson, Director of Cancer Services and Dana Arnaout, Clinical Supervisor on September 13th during the final ceremonies for the Avon Walk in Santa Barbara. This is the 8th grant received from the Avon Foundation for Women and we are very grateful for their support.

Our Navigator Program educates thousands of low-income women in the San Fernando Valley about breast health, provides access to free screening and diagnostics, and personalized care if diagnosed with breast cancer. Educational presentations are done at schools, churches, health fairs, breast cancer support groups, and smoking cessation workshops to inform women about risk factors, early detection, self-exams, screening guidelines, and the importance of scheduling an annual mammogram. Women who are diagnosed with breast cancer work closely with our Oncology Registered Nurse Navigator and a multidisciplinary team to meet their unique needs from diagnosis to post-treatment care. Services include pre-and-post operative surgery education, coordination of patient appointments with other specialties, psychosocial support resources, and a Survivorship Care Plan at discharge.
