

In the United States, someone is sexually assaulted every two minutes and a woman is assaulted or beaten every nine seconds. Child sexual abuse has been called a silent, violent epidemic that can cause long-term psychological issues.

A safe haven

Since 1997, the Center for Assault Treatment Services (C·A·T·S) at Dignity Health – Northridge Hospital has provided compassionate, comprehensive care to adult and child victims of domestic and sexual assault in a supportive and comforting environment. A member of the Sexual Assault Response Team, the Center is the only 24-hour/7-day-per-week facility of its kind in the San Fernando and Santa Clarita Valleys.

Services are performed at no cost to the victim

- Collection of confidential evidence in supportive and dignified settings. This evidence is needed by law enforcement, local district attorneys and child protective services
- Crisis intervention and referrals to state and local agencies
- The reduction of repetitive victim interviews through the use of audio and video recording
- Translation services for non-English speaking individuals
- Coordination of services with Medical, Advocacy and Investigative Agencies
- Community educational outreach to help others understand abuse and the need to report, identify indicators, and the outcomes of failing to acknowledge and report abuse
