



**Did you know Dignity Health – Northridge Hospital has the only Adult and Pediatric Trauma Center in the San Fernando Valley?** Having a local Trauma Center and Emergency Department (ED) is vital to our community. Yet, continuing to provide immediate, life-saving care is becoming increasingly challenging amidst population growth.

### Emergency Room Challenges

Our ED currently sees about 59,000 patients per year. By 2025, those visits are projected reach more than 96,000. The challenges to overcome are numerous and increasing.

During times of medical emergencies, it's critical that our ED offer enough treatment areas, appropriate length-of-stay time periods, first-rate staff and state-of-the-art technology.

### ED Expansion to Meet Population Growth

These vitally needed improvements to Northridge Hospital's ED will be transformational not only to our facility, but to our community and its members' lives.

- Increase the number of treatment stations from 25 to 45
- See and treat more patients sooner
- Prevent patients from being diverted to other facilities due to lack of space
- Maintain patient privacy with additional treatment stations
